Mixing Primo Maxx with line marking paint helps preserve line quality and visibility for up to 50% longer

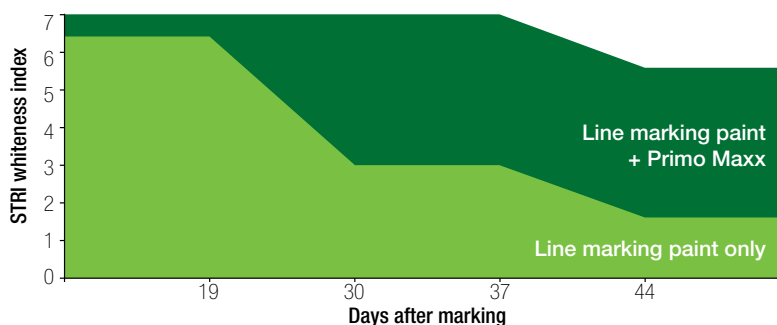

Primo Maxx line marking advice



Independent trials at STRI have shown line marking in tank mix combination with Primo Maxx (lower logo) can reduce frequency of marking by up to 50% compared to paint alone (top logo) and retains a strong healthy playing surface.

Proven line retention



STRI trials have shown line marking visibility, as defined by the STRI Whiteness Index (0 = faded and 7 = White), remains for up to twice as long with the inclusion of Primo Maxx in line marking paint (above). In most situations groundsmen would typically aim to retain lines with a Whiteness Index above 6.

Primo benefits over burnt out lines



- Healthy turf cover is retained
- No bare earth for weeds to get in
- No requirement for over seeding and the end of the season
- Lower cost than glufosinate ammonium
- At the end of the season playing surfaces can be simply converted to other sports without unsightly/confusing old lines

Line marking application rate

Apply Primo Maxx at a rate of 2ml per litre of line marking paint solution.

10 litres line marking paint solution

20 ml Primo Maxx

20 litres line marking paint solution

40 ml Primo Maxx

Primo Maxx can be pre-mixed with line marking paint for wheel-to-wheel applicators. With direct injection spray line-marking applicators, mix Primo Maxx in the clean water-tank. Primo Maxx has been tested and approved with a full range of line marking paints.
